Highlights

November 2025

The Louisiana natural gas spot price has been \$3.20 per MMBTU in the first 10 months of 2025, \$1.08 higher, or 50.9% higher than the first 10 months of 2024. The higher price is caused by demand in the United States being robust. Working gas in storage was 3,946 BCF as of November 20, 2025, according to the EIA estimates. This represents a net decrease of 14 BCF from the previous week, and it was 23 BCF lower than last year at this time, and 146 BCF higher than the five-year average of 3,800 BCF. The expected average natural gas prices for the rest of 2025 and into 2026 are expected to be elevated compared to recent years, around the \$4.00-\$4.50 per MMBTU range, based on current production and demand levels.
