

The West Texas Intermediate (WTI) September crude price average was \$63.96 per barrel. The WTI August crude price average was \$64.86 per barrel, thus September's prices were down 8.4%. Prices have been decreasing from the highs of last year on a steady basis, and down 8.9% as compared to last September. United States crude oil production has reached an all time high, and been increasing in 2025. In June, 2025, the United States averaged 13.5 million barrels per day, with the Gulf producing 1.9 million barrels per day. Compared with May, the U.S. daily average production numbers were basically flat, with a 0.6% increase in average production for the U.S, while production was up 3.7% for the Gulf.
